

City of Kwinana Photography Competition 2026

Terms and Conditions

Entry into the City of Kwinana Photography Competition 2026 (the Competition) signifies acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. Instructions on how to enter and information contained in promotional material form part of these Terms and Conditions.

1. Entries must be submitted by **4pm on Monday, 31 August 2026**. Late entries will not be accepted.
2. The Competition is open to City of Kwinana residents of all ages.
3. Entrants may submit a maximum of three landscape photographs.
4. Entries must be submitted using the entry form available on the City of Kwinana website.
5. Entry forms must include the entrant's full name, address, telephone number and email address. Entries submitted by a person under 18 years of age must include the details and consent of a parent or legal guardian. Incomplete entries may be deemed ineligible.
6. Photographs must capture the people, places or moments that make Kwinana special.
7. Photographs must be taken by the entrant within the City of Kwinana.
8. Entrants must have permission from any identifiable person appearing in a submitted photograph. A parent or legal guardian must provide permission for any person under 18 years of age appearing in a photograph.
9. Basic editing, including cropping, straightening and light colour or exposure adjustments, is permitted. Entries that have been substantially altered or manipulated may be deemed ineligible.
10. Entries must be submitted in JPEG or PNG format and must not exceed 10MB per photograph.
11. Entries must be the entrant's own original work. AI-generated images will not be accepted.
12. Entries must not infringe the copyright, trademark, privacy, contract or intellectual property rights of another person or organisation.
13. Entries that breach these Terms and Conditions or contain unlawful, offensive or otherwise unsuitable content will not be accepted.

14. Entrants retain copyright ownership of their photographs. By entering, entrants grant the City permission to copy, reproduce, publish, adapt and use submitted photographs for the Community Calendar and other promotional, marketing, educational or community purposes without payment, royalties or other compensation.
15. The City will credit the photographer wherever reasonably possible.
16. A maximum of 12 winners will be selected.
17. Each winner will receive:
 - a \$50 prepaid gift card; and
 - their winning photograph featured in the 2027 City of Kwinana Community Calendar.
18. Prizes are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged or redeemed for cash.
19. Winners will be selected by the City of Kwinana Marketing Team. Selection will consider factors including image quality, originality, suitability for the calendar and how well the photograph represents Kwinana.
20. The City reserves the right to select fewer than 12 winners if there are not enough suitable entries.
21. The City's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into with unsuccessful entrants.
22. Winners will be contacted using the details provided on their entry form. The City reserves the right to select an alternative winner if a winner cannot be contacted or does not claim their prize within 14 days of being notified.
23. Employees of the City and their immediate family members may enter the Competition but are not eligible to receive a prize.
24. Members of the City of Kwinana Marketing Team involved in selecting the winning entries, and their immediate family members, are not eligible to enter.
25. Personal information will be collected and managed in accordance with the City's privacy practices and will be used for administering and promoting the Competition.
26. The City reserves the right to amend, suspend or cancel the Competition where reasonably necessary.
